GUIDELINES FOR

PRINCIPAL & COORDINATORS

IN IBO EXAMS

IMPORTANT : The school must strictly follow this guidelines. The OMR sheets must be dispatched to the **Corporate Office (Noida)** on the **next day of the examination**. The Exam Controller team at Noida will wait an additional **10–12 days after the last examination date** to receive the OMR sheets from your school.

◀ **BOF GUIDELINES** ▶

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

- Schools while registering their students with BOF must fill in all columns of School Registration Form completely, and submit the forms by due date.
- Schools are requested to send registration of a **minimum of 50 students** (with at least **10 students per Olympiad**) to conduct the exam.
- All students interested in appearing for the BOF Olympiad are required to register only through their respective BOF Coordinators. Direct or individual registration with the BOF company by students is strictly prohibited.
- In case of less than 10 registrations for any exam, the question paper will be provided via email.

SCHOOL MAY REGISTER FOR EXAMS BY EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING MEANS:

- Fill in and courier the student participation forms.
- Fill and share the excel sheet filled with all the student details provided by BOF.

SCHOOL CODES:

The school code is a unique 6-digit code issued by BOF to a school registering for BOF Olympiads (it is not the same as CBSE or any other affiliation code of education boards). Schools may contact BOF office in Noida (Head Office) / Bhubaneswar (Branch Office) if they do not know their school codes.

There is **No Negative Marking** in **Level 1 Exams**. However, negative marking will be applicable in **Level 2 Exams**.

AWARDS & CERTIFICATES :

- All participating students will receive a "Certificate of Participation" and a detailed "Student Performance Report" which will be uploaded in the portal.
- Top 3 rank holders will be awarded with "State Toppers Citation of Excellence" and state level medals of achievement.
- Subject wise National rank holders securing 100% mark in each subject will receive cash voucher, National Toppers of excellence, certificate & medal.

LEVEL 2 EXAM & AWARDS :

- This online exams will be held in the month of December 2026 for students qualifying to Level 2 at their respective schools/centres fixed by BOF.
- This level 2 exam will be held for students studying in Class 3 to Class 12 for EIBO, MIBO, SCIBO & GKIBO.
- No additional fee is charged for appearing in 2nd level exams.
- Top 3 rank holders will get Gift hamper/Cash Voucher with Certificate of Excellence.
- In case of tie between 2 or more students, the student completing the exams in shortest duration will be declared as winner.
- List of qualifying students will be sent to respective schools and will also be uploaded in our website www.bharatolympiad.org.
- SSIBO, EVIBO, STIBO, AIIBO, CPIBO, HIBO, CMIBO & ARIBO will be single level exams (Offline).
- Admit Cards can be downloaded from the website (www.bharatolympiad.org) before Level 1 & Level 2 exam.
- Level -2 Exam to be conducted under CCTV surveillance and full one hour exam recording to be sent to Board.

RESULT:

- The result of **Level 1 Exams** will be declared in the month of **December, 2026** & **Level 2 Exams** in the month of **January, 2027**.
- The **School Performance Report** will be sent to the respective schools, and the **Individual Student Performance Report** will also be uploaded on the BOF website.

BOF SCHOLAR BADGE ACHIEVER AWARD CEREMONY

- The Ceremony celebrates **outstanding performance** of students in BOF Olympiad in the presence of **Principals, Coordinators, Students, and Parents**.
- Top achievers are honoured with Scholar Badges - Award/Cash Prize/Gift Hamper of Excellence by BOF.
- In recognition of exceptional leadership and commitment, high-performing Principals, Coordinators, and Teachers will be honoured on esteemed national stages for their students' merit and participation.

IMPORTANT

A participation fee of **₹200/- per student per subject** shall be collected by the school. Out of this amount, the school is permitted to retain **₹30/- per student per subject** towards.

- Honorarium for the teacher in-charges to conduct the exam.
- Miscellaneous administrative expenses.
- Postal Expenses.

The school must remit the **consolidated amount of ₹170/- per student per subject** (₹200 – ₹30 retention) to the Bharat Olympiad Foundation.

If a student opts for the **Reference Book**, an additional **₹180/- per subject** shall be collected. From this, the school may retain **₹30/-**, and remit **₹150/- per subject**.
